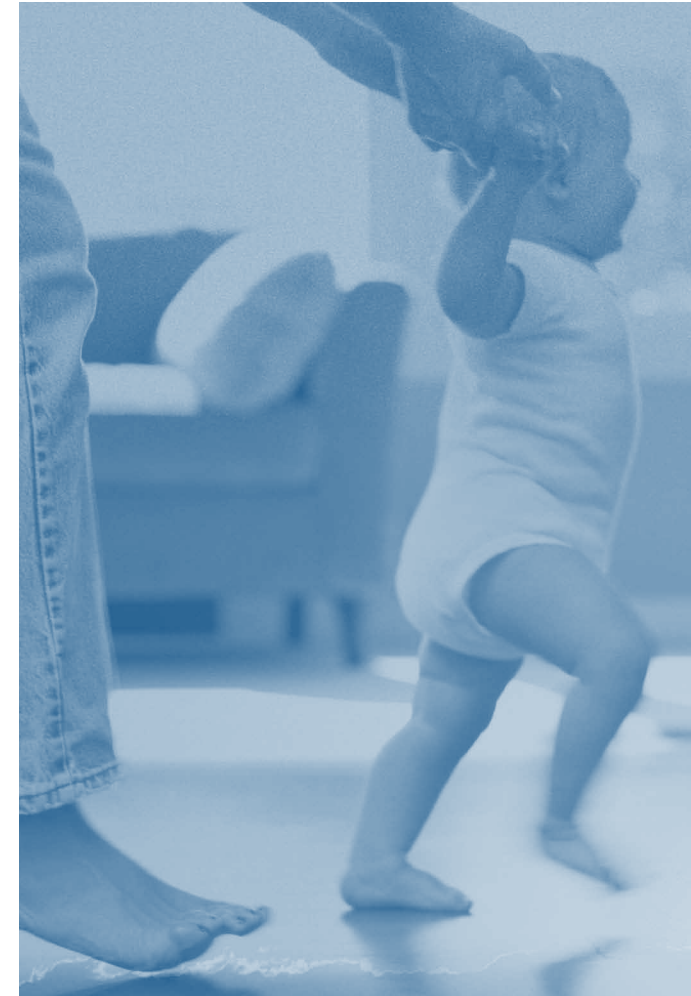

PRE-SERVICE MODULES

24 Hour Pre-Service Training

This training meets the Office of Child Care requirements for new family child care providers and can be used as continuing training for current family child care providers and center staff. The Resource Center will offer all 24 hours of training in a three day period. Dates include March 17, 18 and 19; May 19, 20 and 21; and July 14, 15, and 16.
