Training at Your Center

We are happy to bring the training on-site to your program. Are you a family child care provider? Why not get a group of other child care providers together for a training day?

Registration Reminders

Pre-registration and pre-payment are required for all trainings. Confirmation and directions are mailed only if the registration is received at least one week prior to the class. No cash is accepted; payment may be made by credit card (Visa, Mastercard or Discover), check or money order. Checks are not accepted on the day of the workshop. Registration fees are not refundable unless a class is cancelled by the Resource Center. Transfers are granted only when requested 24 hours in advance. SPECIAL CLASS ANNOUNCEMENTS

Pre-Service Modules

24 Hour Pre-Service Training

This training meets the Office of Child Care requirements for new family child care providers and can be used as continuing training for current family child care providers and center staff. The Resource Center will offer all 24 hours of training in a three day period. Dates include September 6, 7 and 8 and January 10, 11, and 12. Please refer to the training calendar for schedule details.
