Funding for programs/providers and families



Bonuses – the extension of work that was approved a year ago

Status: payments are rolling out now?



Stabilization grants – new idea for monthly payments to providers

Status: challenged by the price tag? (insert commentary about cost of inaction)



Keeping the recent gains – payment rates at 70th percentile, family eligibility, no freeze on waiting list

Status: Senate bill "crossed over"



State budget

Due to be complete/agreed upon by House and Senate: April 3

PreK teachers in Maryland

Several bills in the Maryland House and Senate, and leadership from the Governor's office

Intention: alternative pathways to certification, to value the workforce we have and address the early childhood educator shortage

Situation now:

- HB 1219 "crossed over" to the Senate but changed to take away the alt. pathways language
- SB 893 and Senator energy needed to stay strong for preK success and your success

Maryland State Delegates and Senators need to *continue* to hear from us

- Strong state budget for child care (no cuts!)
- > sustaining scholarship policies
- >alternative pathways for preK educators
- > stabilization grants
- bonus payments promised a year ago
