**Greetings!** 




## CHILD DEVELOPMENT CLASSROOM

The theme for the child development classroom this month is animals in winter. The book teaches children about the different animals in cold climates, how they adapt to the winter weather, and what they eat during this time of year.

# ADULT EDUCATION CLASSROOM

We have accomplished a lot this year! Just to name a few, this year alone, four of our adult ESL learners successfully completed the program and started working and using their language skills; three have been taking PGCC Level 5 classes along with their afternoon sessions. Some have found jobs and are currently working and functioning comfortably in an English-speaking environment. We have successfully conducted pre and post testing and provided necessary guidance and placed our new and existing participants accordingly: 5 students moved up to Level 2, one student moved up to Level 3, and 4 moved up to Level 4.

It makes me happy to see how the participants have been learning about the language and the culture. Some of them even cooked a turkey for the first time on Thanksgiving! We are ready for 2023, which will bring new achievements for our participants and their families!
